Describe your intentions to give back to your community, regarding cultural awareness, while pursuing your educational and career goals.
2. Essay: Write an essay
Technical requirements for essay
 - Two pages
 - Typewritten
 - Double spaced
 - Paper clipped (no staples please)
 - Essay should be written using APA format.
 - Essay will be Times New Roman 12 font with 1" margins
3. Letters of Recommendation: Attach two letters of recommendation sealed in envelopes.
4. Application: Ensure to fill out the application completely.
5. High School Transcript: Attach a sealed certified copy of your high school transcript
6. Applicant Photo: Please include a head and shoulders photograph of yourself.
